## **DIY Flea Deterrent Spray for Dogs**

This natural, non-toxic flea deterrent spray does not kill fleas. It is equal parts ACV & water. It is for spritzing the dog before you head outside and for their bedding. - 1. Lay down towels on a flat surface.
- 2. Place funnels into the small spray bottles.
- 3. Combine equal parts apple cider vinegar and water.
- 4. Label spray bottles.
