### DIY Flea Deterrent Spray for Dogs

*This natural, non-toxic flea deterrent spray does not kill fleas. It is equal parts ACV & water. It is for spritzing the dog before you head outside and for their bedding. This activity could be made for a dog organization that the group could be learning about. (Please check with your veterinarian before using any sprays, etc. on your pet.)*

#### HOW TO

1. Lay down towels on a flat surface.
2. Place funnels into the small spray bottles.
3. Combine equal parts apple cider vinegar and water.
4. Label spray bottles.

#### ITEMS NEEDED

1. Apple cider vinegar (raw, organic)
2. Water
3. Funnels
4. Small spray bottles
5. Towels
6. Label stickers
