



PROJECT IDEA

Peace Pledge Posters (Community Connections) *By Jessica Ryan*

This activity gets students involved in taking ownership of the peace pledge by allowing them to sign it in support. This activity can be done with multiple grade clubs or can be accomplished with one club separated into 6 groups.

HOW TO

- Divide into 6 groups. One sentence from the Peace Pledge will headline each poster.
 - Each sentence will be designated for every grade. Starting with Kindergarten, using the first sentence.
 - The print out of the whole Peace Pledge will go into the corner of the poster. Each prepared poster will be dropped off with each grade's Team Leader.
 - Every student will sign the poster with their name in the spirit of supporting the Peace Pledge daily.
 - These finished and signed posters can be displayed in a common area of the school.
 - At the closing of the school year, a student from each grade can be picked by lottery to take the poster and have their friends sign a note; yearbook-style. This will be theirs to keep.
- ★ K - I pledge to use my words to speak in a kind way.
- ★ 1st- I pledge to help others as I go throughout my day.
- ★ 2nd- I pledge to care for our Earth with my healing heart and hands.

ITEMS NEEDED

1. 6 posters or 3 halved
2. KM365 or motivational stickers
3. 6 Peace Pledge print-outs
4. Markers
5. Recycling Add-on
Option: cut out large words from magazines for headlines

- ★ 3rd- I pledge to respect people in each and every land.
- ★ 4th- I pledge to join together as we unite the big and small.
- ★ 5th- I pledge to do my part to create peace for one and all.
