Making art for or writing letters to children in the hospital is a great way for us to be reminded that we all have the power to spread kindness. During this holiday season, there are those in our community who need extra kindness at difficult times in their lives.

HOW TO

- 1. Use blank paper, note cards, etc. Print the KM365 logo on them if you wish.
- 2. Talk with students about the difficulties of being confined to a hospital bed/room, away from home, and how cheerful art/letters can make that stay brighter.
- 3. Let kids make artwork or write letters designed to cheer up a child in the hospital. They can work in teams or independently if comfortable.
- 4. Contact the Child Life specialist of a local hospital to make arrangements to deliver the letters or have a representative of the hospital visit to pick them up.
