Founded by twin brothers when they were just in elementary school, Cereal4all has been donating cereal to local food pantries since 2016. It is estimated that their annual drives have provided 96,590 bowls of cereal to kids and families during that time.

HOW TO

1. Create a donation bin or bins*.
2. Make signs and [e-flyers](#) advertising your drive.
3. Coordinate with your local food pantry to drop-off your donations or have them picked up at the end of your drive.

4. Be sure to let your community know how much you collected. Cereal4all will also give us a grand total so we can appreciate how our contributions were magnified by working with others.

*Cereal4all recommends a little friendly competition between classrooms with the winning class receiving a cereal party. Be sure to clear this with your administration first and save enough of the cereal donations for the party.
