



The Crayon Initiative collects used crayons from schools, individuals, and businesses to remanufacture new crayon sets for distribution to children's hospitals. They currently send their free crayons to over 240 hospitals, donating to over 624,600 patients. Their organization has kept 47,312,188 crayons from landfills and is an example of kindness to the earth, kindness to others, and how small acts by many have incredible impact.

NOTE This project requires funds to ship the crayons to The Crayon Initiative. They offer reduced shipping rates <u>here</u>. You may wish to ask your school's PTA or a local business (restaurants are a natural fit b/c they can also donate crayons) to donate funds to cover the shipping cost.
